

QUILT SHOW

Background Information: This art show is being coordinated by Hera Gallery, and will be installed at the Rhode Island Philharmonic Orchestra & Music School in East Providene, RI.

The objective of this show is to promote and encourage the art and appreciation of quiltmaking. We strive to present the finest examples of tradition and contemporary quilts being produced in New England today.

Eligibility: This exhibition opportunity is eligible to all quilt makers working within New England. All quilts must be original works designed and executed by the artist. Pre-quilted fabrics and kit-quilts will not be accepted.

Juror: Applications will be evaluated by acclaimed quilt judge, Patricia Harrison.

Deadline for Submissions: April 17th, 2009

Notification: May 1st, 2009

Delivery of Work: Friday May 15th, 2009

Exhibition Dates: May 29th - July 31st 2009

Opening Reception: Tuesday, June 2nd, 2009

Size: One length + one width of the quilt must exceed 120 inches, but not exceed 240 inches. Total width must not exceed 120 inches.

Installation Requirements: All accepted quilts must include a sleeve sewn to the full length of the quilt. No rigid frames, rods, or other mounting devices will be accepted.

Guideline For Entries: Each artist may enter up to three quilts to this exhibition. Please include two images for each entry, one full view image of the completed quilt, and one detail image.

Digital entries should be standard JPEG format, on disk, labeled with applicants last name followed by number (Doe01, Doe02, Doe03, etc.). Please label your CD with your name, and image file names. Images must be in standard JPEG (.jpg) format, and should be no more than 800 KB in size. Images should be roughly 600 x 900 pixels. No Power Point presentations will be accepted.

Please also include a complete image list, brief artist statement, and resume. Please include a SASE for the return of any supplemental materials that you need back.

Fees: Include a \$20.00 application fee.

Notification Of Acceptance: Hera Gallery will contact artists by May 1st, 2009.

Installation: Hera Gallery will take responsibility for the installation of the work. Quilts without the correct sleeve will not be accepted.

Insurance: Although the utmost care will be taken in handling your work, Hera Gallery assumes no responsibility for damage, loss, or theft.

Delivery: Accepted work must be delivered to the gallery by Friday, May 15th, 2009. Work must be ready to hang. Artist is responsible for all shipping costs and shipping containers. Work without pre-paid return shipping and suitable container(s) will become the property of Hera Gallery at the close of the exhibition.

Photography/Publicity: Hera Gallery reserves the right to photograph work for publicity. By entering this exhibition, you agree to the use of your name, likeness, certain personal information, and artwork in any publicity material developed for the exhibition.
