

Materials for Hawaiian Appliqué Class

2 fabrics – 16 – 18” blocks of good quality cotton fabric. Batiks work very well.

If you want to use this for a border you will need ½ yard.

18 – 22” square for the background. This should be a softer fabric that is a good contrast to the design fabric.

Cotton or silk thread to match design fabric

Thread for basting and needle

Applique needles – sharps or straw size 10-12

Pins

Sharp scissors – large to cut through 8 layers of fabric and small sharp pointed pair for appliquéing.

Water soluble glue

Stapler

Thimble if you use one

Pencil to take notes

Iron and ironing board. (provided)

Ott light if you need it. (extension cord will be provided).
