

## Supply List for Fabric Postcards Workshop

- Sewing machine with zigzag stitch (fancy stitches are fun too), instruction book, new needle – size 12 or 14, machine feet – zigzag, embroidery, open toe embroidery, darning or free motion – whichever you have.
- Bobbin area cleaned! And bobbin wound with light colored thread (Bottom Line works will if you have it), extra bobbins.
- Rotary cutter, small mat, 6" x 12" (or similar), ruler.
- Pins, small sharp scissors, regular scissors

These things are nice if you have them (but don't buy them, you can use mine):

- Small iron and mat to iron on, fabric markers, colored pencils, hand sewing and embroidery needles, fabric glue/glue stick.
- Fabric etc. from your stash – don't buy anything. Post card are 4 x 6 so you only need small pieces of novelty/ interesting print fabrics and coordinating colors to go with them.
- Regular and decorative threads that go with your fabric – both matching and contrasting.
- Embellishments such as odd bits of yarn, floss, ribbon, lace, beads, feathers, sequins, broken jewelry, sea shells anything that can be stitched to the surface.

Please do not agonize over this list. I will bring my stash of fabric etc. to share.

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
