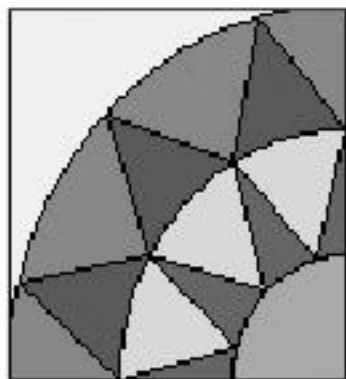


Historical Fan March Block of the Month



This block I found in my EQ6 program as a fan block. The name of it is Rising Sun. Or you can classify it as another version to a New York Beauty. This block is to be done in historical or reproduction prints. And if you don't have any reproduction prints, then any of the the Thimleberries fabrics will do.

There are only two arcs in the block that are to be paper-pieced. If you have never done the paper-pieced technique, you can refer to the November block for directions.

Once the arcs are completed, you will sew template piece A1 to the paper-pieced arc section B together. I found it easier to finger fold the two pieces in half and pin the two sections in the middle first.



Then continue pinning the two sections together as shown below.



Sew. Clip the curve and press seam.

You will continue the previous step for the remaining paper-pieced arc C and template piece D1.

Block measures 8" square
