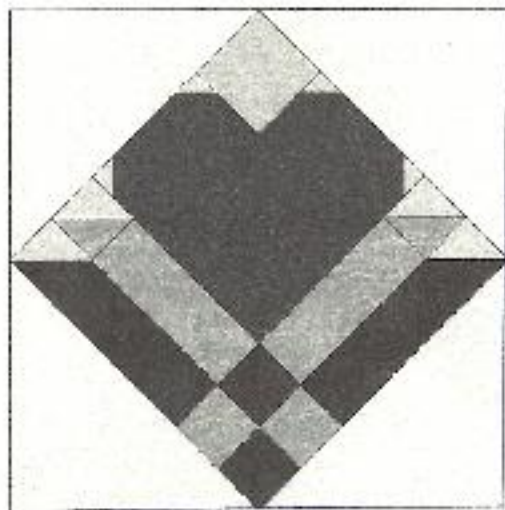
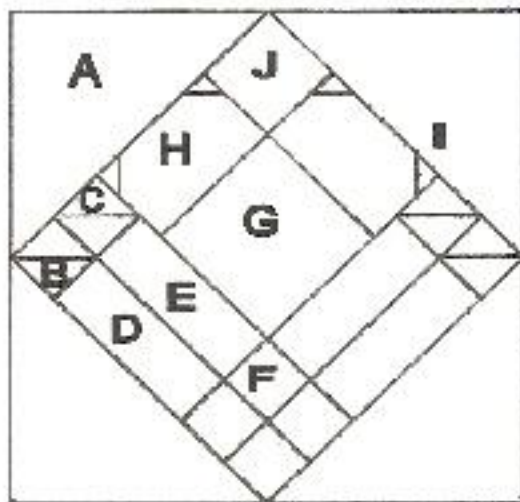


Heart Blossoms February Block of the Month

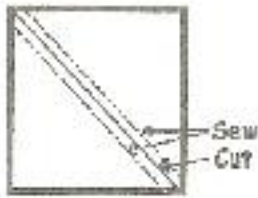


Heart Blossoms comes from *The Thimberies Book of Quilts* by Lynette Jensen. I made one small change by putting the block on point. The only fabric requirement is to use neutral prints for the background.



Cutting

- A cut 2-6 7/8" square cut diagonally
- B cut 2-2 1/4" square (different shades of green)
- C cut 2-2 1/4" square
- D cut 2-1 7/8 x 4 3/4" square
- E cut 2-1 7/8 x 4 3/4" square
- F cut 4-1 7/8" square (different shades of green)
- G cut 1-4" square
- H cut 2-2 5/8 x 4" square
- I cut 4-1 5/8" square
- J cut 1-2 5/8" square



With a pencil draw a line corner to corner on the background fabric of square C.

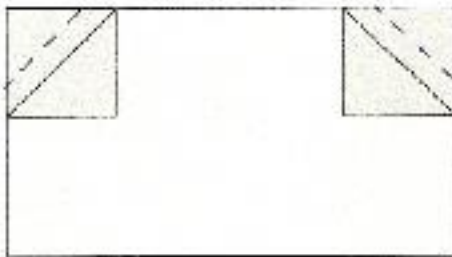
Place square C on top of square B with right sides together and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each sides of pencil line. Repeat three more times.



Cut on pencil line and press seams.



Sew two B and C unit together to form a mirror image as shown. Press seams.



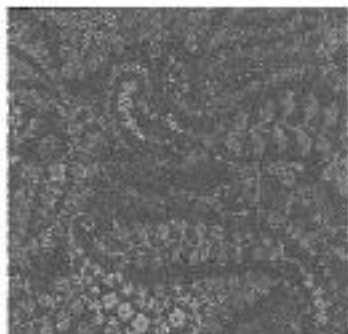
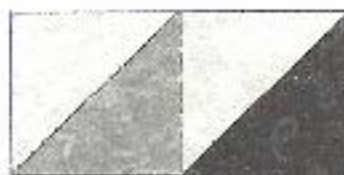
With a pencil draw a line corner to corner on the background fabric of square I. Place square I on each corner of square H. Sew on diagonal line. Leave a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and cut off remaining fabric. Press seams. repeat step one more time.



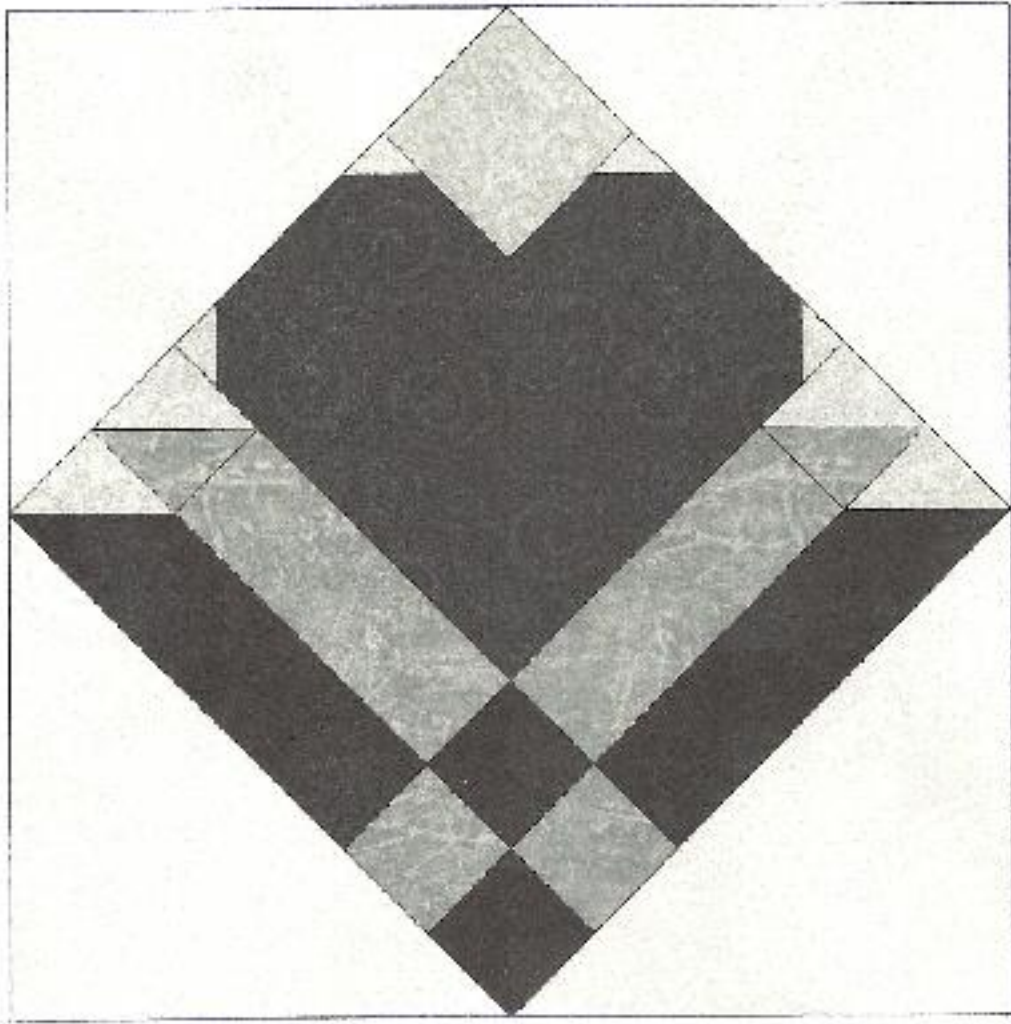
Sew block D and E together. Press seams open. Repeat step one more time.



Sew block F together forming a patch work block.
Press seams open.



Sew blocks into the three sections as shown above.
Then sew sections together. Press seams open.



Sew block A to each side of heart blossom.
Press seams .

Block measures 12 1/2" square.
