

"Zero to Sixty – Put the Pedal to the Metal"

Supply List

The focus of the workshop is to demonstrate how to construct many different blocks using 60-degree wedges. Choose to make several of each for a sampler quilt, one or a few favorites to make a table runner or wall hanging. Different layout and background techniques will be demonstrated as well.

Fabric Requirements:

- Minimum 1/4 yard cuts of a at least six different fabrics (fat quarters, long quarters, half yards or more all work well)
- 1 yard background fabric (optional)

Other supplies:

- Sewing machine in good working order with a quarter inch foot.
- 60-degree ruler OR quilting ruler with 60-degree markings (most quilting rulers have these)
- Rotary cutter and cutting mat
- Basic sewing supplies - scissors, pins, thread, bobbins, seam ripper etc.
- Spray starch
- 12-inch ruler or larger
